Pre-Budget Scrutiny 2025-26 and the Programme for Government

Review of Creative Scotland

Thank you for your letter of 4 September in relation to the Programme for Government commitment to "review the way the culture sector is supported, including a review of Creative Scotland".¹

We note that the review will "examine Creative Scotland's remit and functions as a funding body" and "examine how the overall impact of planned increases in levels of public funding can be maximised to support sustainability in the sector and in participation in the arts".²

It would be helpful if you could provide further information regarding the scope of this review, as well as the timescales to completion, and the process which will be followed.

Release of funding allocated in 2024-25 Budget

We also note the update that "following a period of necessary due diligence, Creative Scotland had now received funding previously allocated to it in the 2024/25 Scottish budget, including £1.8 million for youth music, and £6.6 million that will allow its Open Fund to be re-opened."

The Committee would appreciate further clarity from the Scottish Government regarding the series of events which led Creative Scotland to close the Open Fund for Individuals to new applications.
