1. Minutes: The Conveners Group agreed the minutes of the last meeting.

Matters arising:

- The Group noted responses to the Standards, Procedures and Public Appointments Committee on elected Conveners and to the Rural Affairs and Islands Committee on framework bills.
- 2. Strategic Priority: Cross Committee working Net zero scrutiny: The Group heard a briefing on ongoing scrutiny of net zero issues in the context of future climate change plan and proposed Climate Change Bill. The Group also noted that an update on the work to deliver the Strategic Priority on net zero scrutiny will be provided at the next meeting.

3. Strategic Priority: Participation, Diversity and Inclusion:

- a) **Report on participation, diversity and inclusion activity in 2023/23:** The Group reviewed progress to date in this area and agreed the actions proposed for next year.
- b) Topic selection for next People's Panel: The Group agreed to the delivery of a People's Panel to support the work of the cross-committee on tackling drug deaths and drug harm. In doing so, it also agreed that PACT should work with the Equalities, Human Rights and Civil Justice Committee to support participation in the scrutiny of the Human Rights (Scotland) Bill.
