## **Dear Minister**

I am writing on behalf of the Education, Children, and Young People Committee regarding the Scottish Government's delayed plans for establishing a two-way replacement Scottish Exchange Programme (SEEP).

The Committee heard evidence from Taith and YouthLink Scotland officials on 24 May 2023. The Official Report of that meeting can be found <a href="here">here</a>.

Following on from this session, the Committee would like to invite you to provide evidence at its meeting on **Wednesday 21 June.** 

The Committee also acknowledges your letter of 19 May 2023. Ahead of your appearance, the Committee would appreciate further detail on the following issues:

1. In its <u>Programme for Government 2021-22</u>, the Scottish Government pledged to "develop a Scottish Education Exchange Programme to support the international mobility of staff and learners, and work to re-secure Scotland's access to the Erasmus + Programme" (p 46). Can you clarify what work has been undertaken to date to establish a Scottish Education Exchange Programme?

- 2. Although only established last year, the education exchange scheme in Wales, Taith, already appears to be operating successfully. As such, it may provide a useful model for a future Scottish scheme. The Committee is aware that there has been some interaction between Taith and Scottish Government officials. Can you provide an update on this?
- 3. What assessment has been made of the cost of establishing a Scottish Education Exchange Programme?
- 4. Has the Scottish Government piloted any international learning exchange schemes to date to inform the development of SEEP? If so, please provide further details.
- 5. How would SEEP guarantee two-way movement to ensure that Scottish students can benefit from experiences overseas but also that Scotland attracts overseas students?
- 6. Which governance structures do you envisage being put in place to ensure the operation of SEEP is appropriately managed?
- 7. What is the timeline for SEEP's introduction and why has it not been introduced before now?

The Committee would welcome a response to this letter by **Wednesday 14 June 2023.**
