Independent Review of Community Learning and Development (CLD)

I wrote to the Committee on 5 December 2023 to advise that I had appointed Kate Still to undertake an Independent Review of CLD.

I am writing to inform you that the Scottish Government has published the report of this review '[Learning: For All. For Life. A report from the Independent Review of Community Learning and Development \(CLD\)](#)'. The report is accompanied by the supporting related documents outlined at **Annex A** of this letter.

As I stated in my letter to the committee of 5 December 2023, the Scottish Government will now consider the report findings and its recommendations alongside the Convention of Scottish Local Authorities (CoSLA), and will issue my response and outline next steps in due course.
