CHANGING PLACES TOILETS SCOTLAND FUND

I am writing to you in your role as Convener of the Scottish Parliament's Health, Social Care and Sport Committee to provide an update on funding for Changing Places Toilets.

I have confirmed to Parliament this morning in response to the question you lodged that the Scottish Government will invest £10 million in Changing Places Toilets over the final two years of the Parliament (2025-26 and 2026-27). My officials have been working with partners, including PAMIS, to design the Fund criteria and application process. The Fund will launch in the Summer.

I am very pleased that we are progressing this commitment, which will make a huge difference to thousands of disabled people and their families and carers by enabling them to participate fully in society and access community resources – things which most of us take for granted.

PAMIS is also inviting people to express views on the Changing Places Toilets Scotland Fund or to note interest in funding via the [Changing Places Toilets Scotland Fund Survey](#).
