Thank you for your letter dated 16 November 2022 and the recommendations that the Committee has provided following its scrutiny of the following common frameworks:

- o Common Framework for Air Quality
- o Common Framework for Best Available Techniques
- o Common Framework on ODS and F-Gases
- o Common Framework on Chemicals and Pesticides
- o Common Framework on Radioactive Substances

As you will be aware, the UK Parliament, Senedd Cymru and Northern Ireland Assembly are also undertaking scrutiny of the frameworks. In agreement with the other nations, we will wait for their Committees to complete scrutiny before providing a detailed response to your recommendations to ensure all comments are considered in unison.

I will therefore write to you again once the recommendations have been received from all UK legislatures and the four governments have reached agreement on the proposed changes to be made to the frameworks in response to these.
