EU EXIT LEGISLATION – PROTOCOL 2 WITH SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT

I refer to the above and in accordance with paragraph 34, I am now writing to you concerning the outcome of the GB wide SI The Phytosanitary Conditions (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations 2022 “PH/41”.

PH/41 was subject to negative procedure. The Scottish Parliament agreed on 20 April 2022 that it was content for Scottish Ministers to give their consent to PH/41, which includes Scottish devolved matters, as set out in the notification to the Parliament.

PH/41 was laid on 28 April and came into force 29 April 2022 under the powers conferred by Article 41(3) of European Parliament and of the Council on protective measures against pests of plants (the Plant Health Regulation).

I can confirm that PH/41 was consistent with the consent granted.

I am copying this letter to the Conveners of the Delegated Powers and Law Reform Committee and Net Zero, Energy and Transport Committee.
