Dear Cabinet Secretary,

The Organics (Derogations) (Amendment) Regulations 2022

Thank you for your letter, dated 7 February 2022, relating to a consent notification for the above proposed UK SI.

The Committee considered the notification at its meeting this morning and agreed with the Scottish Government's decision to consent to the provisions set out in these notifications being included in UK, rather than Scottish, subordinate legislation.

The Committee also agreed—

- a) to note that the derogation provided for the introduction of non-organic pullet hens under 18 weeks into organic livestock units no longer aligns with the most recent position in EU law;
- b) to ask the Scottish Government that, in future notifications, it specifies where the proposed provision diverges from the current EU position;
- c) to note that, while the original notification described the proposals as "technical", the Scottish Government has now confirmed that they do constitute policy decisions; and
- d) to note that the UK derogation on the introduction of non-organic pullet hens into organic livestock units expires on 31 December 2022, prior to the deadline for reassessment of equivalence of organic standards under the TCA. In the event that the UK and Scottish Government wish to further extend this derogation beyond 31 December 2022, the Committee asks that the relevant

notification addresses whether this would have any impact on the reassessment of equivalence on organics under the TCA.
