Group Meetings and Activities

27th March 2023 – Introduction to Nuclear Decommissioning in Scotland. Setting the context and background to the industry in Scotland and the Socio-Economic contribution it makes to local communities around the sites. 5 MSPs attended in addition to around 40 other individuals and organisations.

11th September 2024 – The Group discussed the issue of ‘skills’ and the potential skills gap for decommissioning that could exist over the coming years. Various agencies and TU representatives expressed views on the future and it was agreed there needed to be more/better co-ordination amongst organisations to tackle the

issue. It was agreed a motion for debating the issue in the Scottish Parliament should be actioned for early 2025. 9 MSPs were in attendance in addition to 42 non-MSP members. As a direct result of this meeting, the Chair of the CPG (Oliver Mundell MSP) visited Ayrshire College to view the new Kilwinning Campus.

17th December 2024 – AGM where officers were re-elected. The main topic and theme discussed was ‘Radioactive Waste Policy in Scotland’ NDA presented on what is included in the Radioactive Waste inventory in Scotland, its location and how it is being dealt with. There was also discussion on the up-and-coming SG public consultation on HAW policy in Scotland. 5 MSPs attended in addition to 35 non-MSP members.


