MINUTE OF THE SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT CROSS PARTY GROUP (CPG) ON JAPAN ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 10TH SEPTEMBER 2024 at TG20/21 SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT & MS TEAMS.

1. Welcome/Apologies.

Colin Smyth formally opened the AGM of the CPG (Japan) welcoming attendees. Apologies were formally noted from Paul Sweeney MSP.

2. Appointment of Office Bearers

Colin Smith and Alexander Stewart were formally reappointed as the Convenor and Depute Convenor of the Group. Liz Cameron was appointed as the Secretariat for the Committee. These appointments were formally endorsed and approved.

3. Membership Update
