Inquiry into the operation of the Public Sector Equality Duty in Scotland

Overview

- 1. The <u>public sector equality duty</u> (PSED) is a legal requirement for public authorities and organisations carrying out public functions (private or voluntary sector contracted to work on behalf of public authorities).
- 2. The purpose of the PSED is to make sure that public authorities and organisations carrying out public functions think about how they can improve society and promote equality.
- 3. The Committee agreed to an inquiry on the operation of the public sector equality duty on 17 December 2024.
- 4. It launched a <u>call for views</u> on 7 February 2025 closing on 28 February 2025. <u>The responses</u> have all been published.
- 5. This is the second of three evidence sessions in the inquiry. The first session was with public authorities, this, the second session, is with equality organisations, and finally the third session will be with the Equality and Human Rights Commission (EHRC) and the Scottish Government.
