Future agriculture policy: supermarkets and food supply chains

- 1. The Rural Affairs and Islands Committee agreed to undertake pre-legislative scrutiny of the Scottish Government's <u>proposals for future agriculture policy</u>. The purpose of this pre-legislative scrutiny was to explore the wider policy context that a future agriculture policy will operate within and the outcomes it is intended to achieve for food producers, rural communities, and the environment.
- 2. The evidence gathered would also inform the Committee's stage 1 scrutiny of the <u>Agriculture and Rural Communities (Scotland) Bill</u>, which was subsequently introduced on 28 September 2023.
- 3. As part of this evidence taking, the Committee agreed to hold an evidence session with major supermarkets in order to understand better how large retailers work with farmers and other local producers within the wider food production supply chain.
- 4. The Committee received a <u>written submissions from Aldi</u> in relation to this evidence session.
