Women's Health Champion

Note by the clerk

Background

- 1. At its meeting on 27 June 2023, the Committee agreed to hold a one-off evidence session with the Women's Health Champion to provide an update on the role and implementation of the Women's Health Plan.
- 2. The Scottish Government published its Women's Health Plan in August 2021, covering the period 2021 to 2024. The actions in the plan were separated by priority area then into their anticipated timescales for delivery; short, medium and long-term. The plan acknowledges that some of the longer-term actions will take longer than three years to fully deliver. The plan outlined the following priority areas:
 - ensure women who need it have access to specialist menopause services for advice and support on the diagnosis and management of menopause
 - improve access for women to appropriate support, speedy diagnosis and best treatment for endometriosis
 - improve access to information for girls and women on menstrual health and management options
 - improve access to abortion and contraception services
 - ensure rapid and easily accessible postnatal contraception
 - reduce inequalities in health outcomes for women's general health, including work on cardiac disease
- 3. The plan committed to establish a national Women's Health Champion and a Women's Health Lead in every NHS board to drive change and share best practice and innovation. It was intended that the Women's Health Champion would:
 - drive forward strategic change nationally
 - · raise awareness of women's health
 - promote the Women's Health Plan
 - support a network of local women's health experts and leaders and
 - have an integral role in the implementation of this, and subsequent, women's health plans.

- 4. Professor Anna Glasier OBE was <u>appointed</u> as the first Women's Health Champion for Scotland on 26 January 2023.
- 5. Professor Glasier has published three updates to date:
 - April 2023 My first update as Women's Health Champion
 - July 2023 Five enjoyable months
 - October 2023 Women's Health Champion Autumn update
