Scottish Government Budget 2025 to 2026

Introduction

- 1. This paper supports the Committee's evidence session on the Scottish Government's Budget for 2025 to 2026 with the Cabinet Secretary for Rural Affairs, Land Reform and Islands.
- 2. The Committee will scrutinise the spending plans for the Rural Affairs and Islands (RAI) portfolio within the Budget and reflect on how recommendations made by the Committee in its pre-budget scrutiny letter have been incorporated into these plans.
- 3. Following the evidence session with the Cabinet Secretary, the Committee will have opportunity to contribute to the stage 1 debate on the budget to be held on 30 January 2025.

Rural Affairs and Islands Committee pre-budget scrutiny

- 4. Under the terms of the revised budget process, established by the Budget Process Review Group in Session 5, committees are encouraged to undertake pre-budget scrutiny prior to the publication of the Scottish Government's budget. This approach, which normally involves committees publishing a pre-budget letter or report, is designed to influence the Scottish Government's spending plans for the forthcoming financial year.
- 5. Information about the budget process has been produced by SPICe.
- 6. The Committee considered its approach to pre-budget scrutiny at its meeting on 19 June 2024. Consistent with the approach taken in previous financial years, the Committee agreed to take the following dual approach to scrutiny:
 - Scrutiny of the overall RAI portfolio budget.
 - A specific focus on the Marine Directorate's budget for fisheries management operations and science.
- 7. The Committee ran <u>a call for views from 27 June to 9 August 2024, to which 14</u> responses were received.
- 8. The Committee undertook a fact-finding visit to the Marine Directorate science laboratories in Aberdeen on 2 September 2024 and took evidence from stakeholders in <u>a roundtable discussion regarding the budget of the Marine Directorate on 4 September 2024</u>.

- 9. On 25 September 2024, the Committee then <u>took evidence from the Cabinet</u> <u>Secretary as part of the pre-budget process</u>. The Cabinet Secretary <u>wrote to the</u> <u>Committee to clarify certain aspects of the evidence given</u>.
- 10. Following the evidence session, <u>the Committee wrote to the Scottish</u> <u>Government on 31 October 2024</u> setting out its views. The <u>Scottish Government</u> <u>responded to the Committee's pre-budget letter on 5 December 2024</u>.

The Scottish Government's Budget for 2025 to 2026

- 11. <u>The Scottish Government's Budget for 2025 to 2026 was published on 4</u> <u>December 2024</u>.
- 12. Information regarding the RAI portfolio responsibilities, national outcomes and spending plans are set out in Chapter 10 of the budget document (pages 86-93).
- 13. <u>SPICe has prepared a briefing on the Scottish Government's spending and tax</u> plans for 2025 to 2026.
