Inshore Fisheries Management Improvement Programme – evidence session with Marine Directorate officials

- 1. On 5 February, the Rural Affairs and Islands Committee will take evidence from Scottish Government officials on the Marine Directorate's Inshore Fisheries Management Improvement (IFMI) Programme.
- 2. On 26 November 2024, the Cabinet Secretary for Rural Affairs, Land Reform and Islands notified the Committee about the Scottish Government's intention to launch a 10-week call for evidence as part of its IFMI Programme.
- 3. The consultation document accompanying the call for evidence says submissions from respondents will help to inform the development of proposals for a new framework for inshore fisheries management which will be consulted on by the Scottish Government later this year. The Cabinet Secretary said the new framework "will enable us to tailor a range of fisheries management tools to the changing needs of our marine environment and fishers, based on the best available scientific data".
- 4. The purpose of this session is to consider the IFMI Programme objectives and how they relate to the key strands of the Committee's previous scrutiny of fisheries policy: funding, governance and science.
