Future agriculture policy

- 1. Following EU exit, the Scottish Government began the transition from the EU's common agricultural policy towards the development of a new agricultural system of agriculture and rural support schemes.
- The <u>Agriculture (Retained EU Law and Data) (Scotland) Act 2020</u> was passed to retain the EU law regarding the CAP in to Scots law. The Act also gave the Scottish Ministers powers to simplify or improve CAP law.
- The <u>Agriculture and Rural Communities (Scotland) Act 2024</u> sets out the powers for the Scotlish Ministers to create the replacement system of agricultural support.
- 4. The Rural Affairs and Islands Committee scrutinised the proposals for the 2024 Act. In its stage 1 report, the Committee signalled its intention to monitor and scrutinise the development of the new support schemes as would be set out in subordinate legislation and the rural support plan.
- 5. The Committee wrote to the Minister for an update and further information on the Scottish Government's implementation of the 2024 Act on 14 January 2025.
- 6. The Minister responded on 7 February 2025...
- 7. At its meeting on 19 February, the Committee will take evidence from the Minister for Agriculture and Connectivity on the development of a future agriculture policy for Scotland, including the implementation of the 2024 Act.
